Theme

INFLOWENCE develops a concept of enhancement of the competitive potential that a territory can activate through the construction of strong functional relationships between the principal centre and minor centres of the hinterland. The enhancement concerns the creation of participation tools and plan procedures. The project is characterized by an international as well as an economic approach based on agreements and recommendations. The experimentation was actualized through the activation of three activity lines: common tools, governance strategies and pilot action. Polycentrism aims to promote an equitable territorial development system, with the purpose to contrast the emergence of monocentric urban settlements where most functions are concentrated in a restricted area, by promoting networks of urban settlements with the same potential. The partnership worked on areas characterized by common dynamics: lack of economic networks and plans with polycentric structure.

Achievements

Strategic planning models of the existing or potential interconnections between territories (local, regional, interregional) were developed for the creation of a winning solution able to improve their functioning on economic and territorial scale.

The total cost of the project was € 1,926,108.00. Regione Lazio had a budget of € 134,000.00.
