Theme

The mobility for weak demand peripheral areas. The main objective was to reduce the move of people through telematics solutions, able to facilitate access to services and work; to guide users towards the use of collective transport modes; to reduce the environmental impact of transport systems; to organize alternative way of transport with flexible schedules and routes, which guarantee efficient and economically sustainable services.

Achievements

Definition of managerial models for transport services and validation through pilot projects; creation of communication tools to spread the innovative solutions shown in the project; creation of a network of subjects in charge of transport in weak demand areas; organization of transnational seminars to raise awareness about the mobility in the areas concerned; exchange of effective practices. The project ended on 31st May 2013 and was part of the *100 EUrban solution* of the Open Days 2013 in Bruxelles.

The total cost of the project was € 1,288,180.00. Regione Lazio had a budget of € 218,000.00 whereof € 163,500.00 FEDER funds and € 54,500.00 CPN funds.
