Theme

The project analyses the expected territorial scenarios in the regional areas of each partner with regard to the objectives contained in the SSSE, in particular analysing local planning tools, land use and planning, proposing in-depth analysis of infrastructural scenarios as well as natural and cultural networks within MEDOCC context: an important test which allows the comparison of EU policies with planning tools at regional and sub-regional level. The interpretation of Medisdec-Stratmed is in line with the role of pilot projects.

Achievements

Identification of projects aiming at implementing best practices of local land-use planning at a transnational level, while improving the knowledge of regional dynamics with the view of an European planning and deployment of common planning practices in MEDOCC area. Through the pilot project, the participants were able to develop one or more models to build management and intervention tools for local systems. Regione Lazio focused on the development of a land portion outside Rome metropolitan area: the area of Civitavecchia and Viterbo, characterized by considerable and yet not adequately exploited potential. The project acted with the view of territorial balance and strengthening as opportunities to build a strategic territorial agenda for the northern part of the region, in the medium-long term.

Total FESR amount of the project € 1,068,000.00. Regione Lazio had € 168,760.00 at its disposal of which € 84,380.00 FEDER funds (50%), € 84,380.00 CPN funds (50%) as well as a regional co-financing of € 16,876.00. The project was completed and administratively closed with the Determinazione Dirigenziale (Managerial Decree) no. A02862 dated fifth of April 2012.
