Theme

Studying of sustainable mobility models. Identification of strategies to develop a sustainable network of transport, which respects landscape and environmental heritage. The research of methodologies to prevent undesired effects of an expansive development through the efficiency improvement of infrastructures and connections.

Achievements

The objective was to facilitate a more flexible services market. Regione Lazio focused on a group of municipalities in the Colli Albani area.

The total cost of the project was € 1,455,988.00. Regione Lazio had € 258,508.00 of which € 129,254.00 FEDER funds (50%) and € 129,254.00 CPN funds (50%) supplemented by a regional match funding of € 25,850.80 Euro (10%) hence the total amount available was € 284,358.80. The project was completed and administratively closed with the Determinazione Dirigenziale (Managerial Decree) n. A07246 dated 16th September 2013.
